



Qualities of a friend



Instructions for the professional working with the child: Ask the child to draw a friend and to think of qualities that they have: are they kind, caring, etc.

If the child can write the qualities, let them write them around the friend that they have drawn, if they cannot write, you can talk about the qualities of their friend, or you can ask the child if they would like you to write the qualities of the friend for them.

After completing this exercise, you can share/look at the next resource included: qualities of a good friend, examples- explore these with the child after they have drawn the picture and explored/ shared their friend's qualities. You can read the qualities to the child and ask them if there are any that they would like to add to their picture.

Draw a friend and what qualities they have, are they:

Kind, caring, do they share things with you, are they ok with you having other friends? **What other qualities do they have?**
